Purposes: In memory of Dr. Joseph Su, a leader and member of TAI;
And to recognize and encourage the outstanding achievements
of second generation Taiwanese.

Eligibility: The applicant must be:

- child of a Taiwanese parent;
- currently attending an accredited university or college
as an undergraduate student.

Criteria: Each applicant will be evaluated based on the followings:

- A. Scholastic achievement;
- B. Extra-curricular activities;
- C. Community services, especially in the Taiwanese community;
- D. An essay on career objectives;
- E. A letter of recommendation.

Application: Complete the application form with a latest transcript and an essay,
and ask a faculty member of the applicant's school or a person who
knows the applicant well to write a letter of recommendation.

Deadline: August 31 (postmarked)

Selection: A committee appointed by the TAI Board shall select two among all
applicants.

Awards: Each winner will receive a citation and a monetary prize of \$1,000
at the annual TAI General Meeting.
